

Snow Removal Program – Volunteer Application

Duties: Clearing of walkways of snow during the winter months for seniors and persons with disabilities as part of the volunteer program. Volunteers will generally be assigned addresses within their own neighborhood and within walking distance of their own home. This activity involves moderate physical exertion and may not be suitable for persons with disabilities or other related health issues. Ability to shovel snow is essential. Reliability is very important.

Requirements: All volunteers must supply two personal references. Volunteers under the age of 18 will require parental consent and need to work in a 'buddy' system. Seniors should consult with their doctor about appropriate fitness level required for this activity. All volunteers must supply their own snow removal equipment. Volunteers shall not receive any compensation for their services.
