The City Clerk is required to notify the Council President 60 days prior to a citizen vacancy so that the Council President may announce at the next regular meeting of the Common Council that a vacancy is upcoming. Applications for those interested are available through the Office of the City Clerk. **Persons "must have been residents of the City of South Bend for not less than one (1) year prior to appointment and shall continue such residency as a qualification for appointment".** (See: South Bend Municipal Code § 2-12.3 for further details).
