Dear Neighbor,

For the next seven months, this letter will come from Mark Neal, the former City Controller who will serve as Deputy Mayor during my deployment to Afghanistan. Under Mark's leadership, residents can expect the same efficiency from city government, and the administration will remain focused on a process of continuous improvement.

Before deploying, I'll deliver the State of City address at 7:00 pm on Wednesday, February 12 at Century Center's Bendix Theater. All South Bend residents are encouraged to attend. I will reflect on the City's achievements in 2013 and outline our priorities for the year ahead. The address will include initiatives to continue to reduce violence, strengthen neighborhoods, increase employment, and streamline city government.

As we endure a difficult winter, I want to thank residents for their patience and cooperation with City employees who have worked hard, often in dangerous conditions, to help make it safer and easier for us to navigate in the snow and bone-chilling cold. There are approximately 2,200 lane miles of pavement to be plowed and our crews are out 24 hours a day when the snow is at its heaviest. Residents are asked to wait to report unplowed streets until 36 hours after snow has stopped falling to allow crews adequate time to complete all of their assigned routes. As always, if residents have any non-emergency concerns, please call 311, the City's customer service line, Monday-Friday, 7:30 am-5:30 pm.

Please join me in thanking Mark Neal for his service to the City. I'm proud to serve our country, but I will miss my hometown and look forward to returning in September to continue you the work you hired me to do.
