Summer is finally here and with it longer days and more outdoor fun throughout the City. Tickets are still available for the City-sponsored Country Music Festival to be held at Four Winds Field on Saturday, June 21. Country duo Big & Rich and artist Jo Dee Messina will headline the event. Tickets are \$35 through June 20. Each ticket sold in advance will include a voucher for a Silver Hawks game ticket. At the door, tickets are \$45.

Tickets may be purchased at the O'Brien Recreation Center Administrative Offices, Monday-Friday, 8am-4:30pm; South Bend Silver Hawks Box Office, Monday-Friday, 10am-5pm; or by calling 574-235-9988.

The Parks and Recreation Department is also gearing up for its many summer camps, activities, and classes for all ages. Kid's World Summer Day Camp still has openings available, and Elbel and Erskine Golf Courses are offering a special rate of \$20 on the 20th of each month.
