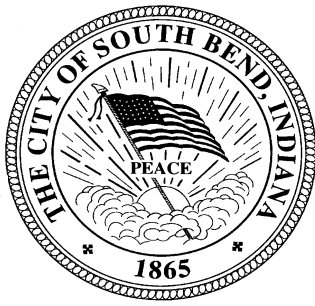

Dear Neighbor:

One of the City administration’s major goals is making sure the “basics are easy.” Raising a family, sending kids to school, paying the bills, and going to work can be hard enough, and residents and businesses shouldn’t have to worry about public safety and emergency response. The men and women of the South Bend Fire and Police Departments dedicate their careers to this goal and we should all be thankful for their efforts and sacrifices.

Still, violence—particularly gun violence—happens on our streets and threatens to disrupt the daily life of the people of South Bend. More alarmingly, many of the culprits are young people deciding between a productive life and a criminal life.

In April, my office convened an Anti-Violence Commission to focus on this serious issue in our community. With over 30 members from a diverse cross-section of law enforcement, judicial, civil society, education, faith, and public health sectors, the Commission’s primary work will concentrate on gun violence intervention and suppression.

The Commission is chaired by Chief of Police Ron Teachman and Bishop Eddie Miller, a member of South Bend’s Board of Public Safety. Through education, working groups, updated policing strategies, and communication, the Commission will attempt to reduce or stop the shooting in our neighborhoods.

Like any major community effort, the Commission will need all of us to contribute. If you witness any crime or hear a gun shot, call **9-1-1**. If you would like to call the South Bend Police Department with non-emergency information, please call **(574) 235-9201**.

Together, we can send the message that gun violence will not be tolerated in South Bend.
