Dear Neighbor,

I'm proud to report that we've reached our goal in the "1,000 Homes in 1,000 Days" initiative. We set out to answer the community's call to address boarded up homes in South Bend. And we have reached our target of addressing 1,000 vacant or abandoned houses ahead of schedule—repairing the ones that could be fixed and removing those that could not. Without crucial support from so many residents and organizations across the city, we could not have accomplished this challenge. Later this year, we plan to reconvene the Vacant and Abandoned Task Force of community leaders to discuss lessons learned and next steps.

The Street Department will start its annual leaf pick-up program in late October. The ReLeaf program will run from Monday, October 26 through Monday, November 30. A schedule of areas served is enclosed and available online at southbend.in.gov/government/service/releaf-leaf-pickup.

Here are some helpful steps from the Street Department to streamline the pick-up process:

1. Please rake leaves to the curb line but **do not rake leaves into the street**, as this will plug the street drains, which could cause flooding during rain.
2. Avoid parking on top or in front of leaf piles along curb lines, as this hampers collection crews.
3. Do not contaminate leaf piles with sticks, trash, or other debris. To prevent equipment damage, crews cannot collect such piles and property owners will be responsible for their disposal.
4. Burning leaves is a violation of City ordinance.

The City also reminds residents that plastic bags with leaves will not be collected. A City ordinance prohibiting the use of plastic bags for yard waste went into effect on January 1, 2014.

According to the ordinance, leaves and other yard waste for pickup must be placed in biodegradable paper bags or other containers approved by the City, and separated from other garbage. Individual bags or containers may weigh no more than 35 pounds.

It's also a great time of year to check out all the great programming South Bend Parks and Recreation has to offer. From the River City Basketball Fall League to fitness classes to nature programs at Rum Village to day trips for seniors and much more, information is available at sbpark.org or by calling 574-299-4765.

We're grateful for your participation in City activities of all kinds. Your community engagement is an essential part of building a stronger South Bend.
