Dear Neighbor,

Mark your calendars for the first annual Mayors' Bike Ride to be held Sunday, May 22 from 7 to 11 am. This family-friendly recreational ride will begin at three locations: St. Patrick's County Park; Howard Park, South Bend; and Central Park, Mishawaka.

The route mostly follows trails along the St. Joseph River. It will be a great opportunity for bicyclists of all ages to enjoy the outdoors. As our community's bike culture continues to grow, the Mayors' Ride is a chance to experience the miles of trails with fellow cycling enthusiasts. South Bend has more than 72 miles of bicycle routes, including 18 miles of off-street pathways and 20 miles of striped bike lanes.

The Mayors' Ride is free of charge. A \$10 per person donation is suggested to support the education initiatives of the event's co-sponsor, Bike Michiana Coalition. For more information or to register, visit bikemichiana.org.

Also this spring, the City of South Bend continues its Curb and Sidewalk Repair Reimbursement Program to assist property owners in making needed repairs to curbs and sidewalks abutting their properties. This cost-share program helps improve safety, access, and aesthetics in neighborhoods throughout the city.

The reimbursement rate is \$20 per linear foot for sidewalk and \$15 per linear foot for curbs. All work must be performed by a private, bonded contractor to be selected by the property owner. For additional information, please call 311, the city's resident service line, Monday-Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

As a reminder, changes to the city's yard-waste program went into effect with the beginning of the season's collection process. Residents are now required to rent a city-furnished container to receive automatic weekly yard-waste collection, which will happen on the same day as trash pickup. A 45- or 96-gallon yard-waste container will be provided for \$2 per month charged via residents' utility bill, for the yard-waste season, which runs from April 1 through November 30.

Residents who choose not to rent a city yard-waste container will be allowed one special yard-water pickup per month—which must be scheduled by calling 311. Monthly special pickups will be limited to 10 paper bags of yard waste. For special pickups, leaves and hedge clippings must be placed in paper bags and branches must be bundled. The City of South Bend and its residents continue to work together to make this a great place to live, work, and raise a family. Looking forward to seeing you out and about this spring, taking advantage of all South Bend has to offer!

With the arrival of spring, the city is doing more to straighten up alleys and streets. To report furniture, stray tires, and other debris in alleys, residents are encouraged to call 311, Monday - Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm. Residents may also notify the City of illegal dumping at southbendin.gov/government/content/311-south-bend-report-issue.

To keep alleys clean, residents are asked to:

- Bag all trash before throwing it in a dumpster or trash can.
- Pick up loose trash in the alley. Loose trash creates an unhealthy environment by attracting animals, insects and rodents.
- Not to put trash on the ground.
- Not to overfill dumpsters.
- Keep dumpster lids closed.
- Not to place furniture and other large items in dumpsters, or on top of dumpsters.
- Pull weeds and trim overhanging trees.

Working together we can keep South Bend clean and beautiful.

There are new yard-waste rules for South Bend residents.

To receive automatic weekly yard-waste collection in 2016, residents must rent a yard-waste container.



A 48- or 96-gallon yard-waste container will be provided for \$2 per month, or a total of \$16 for the yard-waste season, which runs from April through November.

To sign up for yard-waste bin, residents need to call 311 (574-233-0311) between 7:30 am and 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday or use 311's online form:


