Dear Neighbor,

Four years ago, this community gave me the chance to serve as mayor of South Bend in a campaign based on the idea that our city was ready for a fresh start. Sworn in on New Year's Day 2012, our administration team immediately got to work delivering on that promise.

We transformed our approach to economic development, positioning South Bend to take advantage of a recovering economy by creating thousands of new jobs. We simplified customer service by establishing a 311 line that has handled over half a million resident calls and counting. We tackled 1,000 vacant and abandoned houses in fewer than 1,000 days. Perhaps most significantly, I had the privilege of standing with my five predecessors and thousands of fellow residents as we celebrated our City's 150th birthday in an inspiring show of civic pride that sent the simple and resonant message: South Bend is back.

As we prepare for a second term it is a moment of great opportunities, as well as substantial challenges. Initiatives and innovations years in the making continue to bear fruit and hold great promise for the future. But none of our gains can be considered fully secure, nor our potential realized, unless we continue to work with a sense of urgency.

We will work to finish what we started when it comes to addressing vacant properties, driving economic growth, and updating our street design to better promote safety and economic expansion. Meanwhile, we will seek to break new ground in updates to our parks and recreation system, support for local early childhood efforts, partnerships for public safety, and technological improvements to better serve residents.

We are already getting down to work—along with the nine Council members who will be sworn into office alongside me at the beginning of the year—to prepare a second term that will continue South Bend's remarkable comeback.

With Election Day behind us, this administration's work continues. I am grateful to fellow residents for the chance to continue helping to grow South Bend as a truly open, connected community where everyone can thrive.

I wish everyone a joyous holiday season and a happy and productive 2016.
