Dear Neighbor,

With the academic year over and the South Bend Cubs season well underway, summer is in full swing even before the official start of the season. Many outdoor activities offered by the City will help residents enjoy the summer—here are just a few:

- Kennedy Water Playground is open daily. Hours are Monday-Saturday 11 am-5 pm and Sunday 12-5 pm.
- Potawatomi Pool is open from 12-6 pm daily, except Wednesdays, when it's open 2-8 pm. Potawatomi Pool offers aqua aerobics on weekdays.
- The East Race Waterway is open for rafting and kayaking on weekends, 12-5 pm Saturday and 12:30-4:30 pm Sundays. The East Race also offers a climbing wall.
- The Outdoor Film Series will be held at parks throughout South Bend on Friday evenings through September 9. Movies begin at dusk, weather permitting. Bring lawn chairs or a blanket and enjoy the shows.

South Bend Parks and Recreation also presents two free Sunday concert series—the East Race/Seitz Park Concert Series and the Potawatomi Park Concert Series. Both series run Sundays from June 26 through August 28.

Fridays by the Fountain helps kick off the weekends with a free concert from 11:45 am to 1:15 pm every Friday through August 26 at the Jon R. Hunt Plaza in front of the Morris Performing Arts Center. Food is available from local vendors.

The 16th Annual Kids' Triathlon will be held on July 9 at Potawatomi Park for boys and girls ages 5 to 14. The course includes swimming, biking, and running. Register by June 22.

This summer South Bend also will co-host the prestigious US Open National Playoffs Midwest Sectional Qualifying Tournament, June 11 – 14, at Leeper Park. Returning for the seventh season, the tennis tournament provides the opportunity for players 14 years of age and older to earn a berth into all five draws at the US Open.

From the Office of the City Clerk

Property owners in the City of South Bend are advised that an amended ordinance concerning tall grass and weeds on their property is now in effect. The amendment sets the maximum height for grass at 9 inches and sets the fine for violations at \$250.

It makes exceptions for sustainable vegetation such as native grasses.

Previously, grass could be either 9 or 12 inches high, depending on the type of property.

The amendment also establishes fees and penalties for property owners who repeatedly violate the ordinance. Such property owners now face a fine of \$500 to \$1,500 per violation plus fees of \$400 to \$500 per year.

Residents can alert the City to violations by calling 311, Monday-Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Residents are also reminded of what is called the "Good Samaritan Law" (IC 34-30-26-5) which allows neighbors to mow the grass of an abandoned property without fear of being sued or charged with trespassing. The law also allows residents to paint over graffiti.

Let's all contribute to keeping South Bend beautiful.
